In today's fast pace world and constantly ever-changing times, I don't think it's a stretch to say that the days of printing and distributing a church directory are far gone. Keep in mind, each time you print a directory it's almost immediately outdated and this is especially true for churches in Southwest Florida, including Fort Myers Christian Church. From not only members leaving the church to new members arriving, but also to changing addresses, phone numbers, and/or emails. Additionally, there are new ministries, activities, staff transitions, and even part-time worship additions such as our students from Florida Gulf Coast University. In short, there must be a better way to keep an updated directory that is useful for the congregation.

In the past August board meeting, we voted to move forward creating an online church directory that will allow us to meet the above challenges and for this to be easily accessible for our church members as we stay current. By the end of September, we will have a user-friendly web software that allows members' photos,

addresses, phone numbers, birthdays, and anniversaries, all in one spot. Guess what? You will not even have to worry about the hassle of getting another picture as you can simply email a picture of what you want to be in the directory. If you have a smart phone, you will even be able to download a free mobile app so that you will have the directory wherever you go and pull up addresses in a flash. This will help us to put a face to one another whether we are praying or sending out a "thinking of you card" to one of our beautiful shut-ins or someone who is unable to attend worship during this season due to their health.



Let me answer two questions that might be on your mind and shared at our board meeting.

- First, you might be asking yourselves what about the safety of everyone's information. Please note the directory will not be available for the "public" to view. Instead, there will be an online members' directory website that you will go to, and we plan to have a direct link from our website as well as Monday email. Furthermore, each family will create their own unique login with a verified email address and password. This will operate similar to signing into your email. Therefore, from any computer, tablet, or smart phone, you can login with your username and password to access the directory.
- Secondly, a few people might be wondering what happens if you are unable to go online or just still prefer a hard copy of a directory to place on your nightstand. There is no reason to fret as there will be an option to print out a PDF of the online directory.

Within the next week, you should receive an email regarding a picture for the directory.


