"You will see greater things than these," says Jesus at the close of the very first chapter of John's lengthy twenty-one-chapter Gospel. Not only would Nathanael and those initial disciples whom Jesus called, but also the outcasts, the outlaws, and outsiders would see greater things. The blind would receive sight, the deaf would be able to hear, the unclean would be made clean, the broken would be whole, the prisoner would be set free, and the list goes on and on! Indeed, Jesus is in the business of doing greater things. Furthermore, I believe God is still in the business of doing new and amazing things right here at Fort Myers Christian Church (Disciples of Christ).

Although it's an automatic to get excited for an Easter celebration in the sanctuary with your church family, I

want to share a few meaningful services we will have leading up to this moment:

• First, this year we are going to make a big deal out of Palm Sunday! And to any critics, why not or how could we not? Remember when the Pharisees rebuked Jesus for the crowds getting too loud with their excitement and praises, Jesus answered them "I tell you, if these were silent the stones would shout out" (Luke 19:40). We are going to have our



first ever outside Palm Sunday Service! Additionally, during this service we will have a special moment when we dedicate the beautiful palm trees that have been recently planted in honor of Bob Skaggs.

- Secondly, on March 29, we will have an extended Good Friday Service as we participate in the stations of the cross. Both prior and after the service, you can walk around to view the traditional fourteen stations of the cross as you remember the passion of our Lord and Savior. From the first station of Jesus being condemned and sentenced by Pontius Pilate to Jesus being laid in the tomb. Throughout the sanctuary there will be a picture, Scripture, and prayer for each station so that you can have a moment of reflection and make the most out of this sacred time.
- Thirdly, for all my early risers, you are invited to arrive early for a meaningful Easter sunrise service! Afterwards, there will be a light breakfast provided in the fellowship hall and time to converse



with friends. In fact, we are playing with the idea of moving the traditional worship service to begin 10am instead of the regular time of 10:30am. Whether you decide to come to the sunrise service or traditional service in the sanctuary, we hope you plan to come into the fellowship hall for a time to connect with one another on Easter.

I hope you found at least one of the above upcoming worship services a reason to get excited. Even more, if you found one of these really exciting, please use this as an opportunity to invite a friend, neighbor, or relative to Fort Myers Christian Church (Disciples of Christ). Not only am I super thrilled, but actually my head is spinning in circles and I'm exhausted from already thinking about all joy and fun in planning the meaningful services. Yet, it will definitely be worth it!
